



## **2018-19 USA Hockey Junior Classification Request for Non- Import Classification Waiver**

USA Hockey Junior Rules & Regulations limit the number of Non-US Citizens rostered per team.

However, players that have been registered members of USA Hockey for three or more consecutive seasons, and during this time, played for USA Hockey member teams, may qualify for non-import status.

With that understanding, upon receiving the request for Non-US Citizen Import Classification Waiver, the waiver will be reviewed for seeking non-import status.

**A non US citizen must be a member of USA Hockey for three (3) consecutive seasons or more and residing in the US prior to requesting participation as a member of a USA Hockey junior team. The player must be a registered member and participated with USA Hockey member programs during this period. If the player has played junior hockey outside of the US, the player would not be eligible for non-import status. Any player granted a waiver for non-import status is still subject to IIHF and/or USA Hockey/Hockey Canada transfer agreement protocols. All decisions on waivers are final and cannot be appealed to USA Hockey.**

1. Played a minimum of three (3) seasons at youth/junior level , in a USA Hockey member program (list years of participation & program/club name)
2. Resided in the US during same period (list residence)
3. A brief description why player is here in the US and how long they have resided in the US
4. Any additional information on your behalf that would favorable support your waiver request
5. Name of team you are seeking to join
6. Coaches name and contact information (phone & email)
